**"Smith Students Join to Design an Imaginative World that Engages Children in Engineering"**

**Glenn Ellis, Ph.D., M.A., Professor of Engineering, Smith College**

Professor Glenn Ellis is a national leader in engineering education and has received many prestigious awards, including The Outstanding Baccalaureate College Professor of the year from the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching, and honors for distinguished Teaching at Smith College. He understands that the teaching of engineering (the "built environment") must also include history, ethics, and philosophy.

Professor Ellis believes that reforming engineering education—and the role of women in engineering—needs to start well before the college level. To help meet this need, Ellis works extensively with K-12 educators. As part of this effort, he has collaborated with Smith students and professionals to develop the Talk to Me educational website for middle school children.
