HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PAST YEAR

Last year we had four successful and interesting programs:

December: Perry Borman, Executive Director of the Palm Beach County Food Bank, discussed how the food bank provides food to about 100,000 people in the county each month through their system of food recovery and distribution. He estimates that one in six of the 1.4 million Palm Beach County residents are "food insecure." He lead a tour of the food storage facility in Lantana.

January: Associate professor of engineering at Smith Glenn Ellis described his program to engage Middle School girls in engineering through the use of storytelling in the classroom. His research focuses on "the use of narrative and knowledge building to encourage deep intentional learning in engineering and science."

February: We toured the historic 1916 Palm Beach County Courthouse in West Palm Beach and the Johnson History Museum, which has a fascinating display of early Palm Beach County artifacts and photos.

March: Our trip to The Wick Theatre and Costume Museum in Boca Raton included a jaw-dropping tour of the exhibit of fashion from Broadway plays and a lovely lunch at the Tavern at The Wick. We heard the story of the founder, Marilyn Wick, who has a genius for taking hold of opportunities all her life and making a success of them, from a construction cleaning service to costume rental, and finally transforming the Caldwell Theater into a significant presence on the South Florida arts scene.

We hope you will enjoy attending this year's programs.
