Program: Finding Your Path: From Public Service to MA Tourism

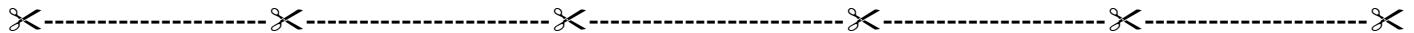
A Conversation with Keiko Matsudo Orrall '89, Executive Director of the Massachusetts Office of Travel & Tourism.
