We are so proud of our classmate Cecilia Robinson Edwards, who you may have seen has been appointed a Trustee. Cecilia was our class president along with Kecia Brooks-Smith Lowe for the previous reunion, and the Reunion co-chair for our 30th Reunion. Her appointment as a Trustee also gives her a position on the Alumnae Association Board of Directors, and if you have questions or concerns, she encourages us to reach out to her to represent these.

Cecilia is a partner and principal solutionist at Wavestone, a global management consulting firm focused on supporting large enterprises to drive impact along their generative AI and sustainability transformation journeys.

Cecilia produces and hosts *The Business of Impact*, a weekly podcast on this topic. Cecilia spent nearly seven years at The Boston Consulting Group (BCG) and later led The Foundation for Community Empowerment (FCE), a nonprofit organization where she focused on early childhood education, public school reform, affordable workforce housing, community health, nonprofit capacity building, and community research. Starting her professional career as an officer in the United States Air Force, Captain Cecilia Edwards was the launch manager on the Titan Satellite Launch program, supporting the successful launch of five satellites. After receiving her A.B. in mathematics from Smith, she went on to get an M.B.A. from the Haas School of Business at the University of California, Berkeley.

Fundraising Update

At the end of the last fiscal year (June 30, 2024), our class participation giving rate was 17% and we exceeded our goal for contributions to the Smith Fund, which provides the college with the most flexibility. We knocked it out of the park, with \$84K raised toward a Smith Fund goal of \$75K! A big **thank you** to all who made that happen!

Let's see if we can beat those numbers this year—25% participation rate anyone? The College also set our Class of '88 fundraising goal for this year at \$100K. We can do it!

Our class remains at 21 members of The Grécourt Society. If Smith has already been named as a beneficiary of your will, retirement account, trust, donor advised fund, or other account, please let the college know by contacting giftplanning@smith.edu. You will be welcomed into The Grécourt Society!

Have you heard that there's a new Grécourt Match III? As of July 1, 2024, an anonymous donor, whose late wife was a member of the Class of '59, pledged \$1.8m as matching financial aid funds.10% of your new planned gift will be released to outright financial aid (limit of \$10k per planned gift).

For example:

- You make a planned gift to Smith after July 1, 2024, such as:
 - Document a bequest in your will.
 - Make Smith a beneficiary of your retirement plan.
 - Fund a charitable gift annuity that pays you a fixed income for life.
- Your gift can be for any purpose, although financial aid is especially welcome.
 - If, for example, the gift is \$10,000:
 - \$1,000 of matching funds goes into the Smith endowment for financial aid immediately.
 - Your gift makes a powerful impact now, and a powerful impact later.
